Dear customer,

For more than a century tea has been an inseparable constituent of central European gastronomy. Initially, it was prepared in its pure loose form, but the invention of the tea bag containing finely cut tea proved revolutionary. Since then, preparing the drink has simplified significantly, and the tea bag has dominated gastronomy and the entire tea sector for many decades.

However, it would seem that people are ever more interested in a return to past methods, which is backed up by a rise in the popularity of loose tea. Therefore, in order to broaden the appeal of tea in its loose form, Oxalis has launched the OXABAG. This original product provides the exact same indulgent sensation of drinking loose tea, but does so in a way corresponding to the fast pace of life today.

The OXABAG range encompasses a selection of 12 loose teas from our existing assortment, packed with great care in tea bags of 5g (fruit infusions) or 4g (other types). Naturally, they are completely identical to the loose teas bearing the same names – sharing the self-same blends and methods of manufacture. In fact, it is easy to make out the tea leaves and other components present within the bags, and just one tea bag enables 400 – 500 ml of delicate tea to be conveniently prepared.

In recent years, Chinese blooming teas have become hugely popular. We offer 14 types of these rare teas, which come individually packed especially for the gastronomy sector. The high quality of the tea (white or green) and impressive display during infusion (the tea opens up to reveal a colourful flower) is sure to please even a tea connoisseur.

A trend visible in western European countries is ever greater emphasis on typical loose tea in modern gastronomy. Consequently, so as to meet this demand, we offer everything necessary to make this viable. Therefore, using the appropriate accessories (strainers and infusers, cups, teapots), a customer familiar with their use can prepare tea in the traditional way themselves. Furthermore, it is possible to choose from an enormous range - more than 400 kinds.

It has been Oxalis' endeavour to make teas available for the gastronomy sector which are the complete antithesis of mundane tea bags with crushed tea. It is our impression that this particular market is seeking out less typical solutions, so we truly believe there is something to suit everyone's tastes from the possibilities outlined in this brochure.

- 200005 **Wild Sour Cherry** (10 x 5g)
Ingredients: Elderberries, raisins, rose hip skin, apple pieces, organic hibiscus, sour cherries (min. 8.5%), blackcurrants, flavouring, hawthorn flowers and leaves.
- 200009 **Wild Strawberry** (10 x 5g)
Ingredients: raisins, elderberries, rose hip skin, apple pieces, organic hibiscus, blackcurrants, flavouring, roses, blackberry leaves, strawberry pieces (min. 0.9%).
- 200018 **Granny's Garden** (10 x 5g)
Ingredients: elderberries, apple pieces, organic hibiscus, black chokeberry, beetroot, blackberries, flavouring, blackcurrants, raspberry pieces, blackberry leaves, strawberry pieces.
- 210002 **China Jasmine with Flowers** (10 x 4g)
Ingredients: original Chinese green tea containing jasmine blossom (min. 1%), which is an extremely popular combination in China.
- 210007 **China Sencha** (10 x 4g)
Ingredients: Japanese type Sencha is now increasingly grown in Chinese tea gardens, and is a brew honey/yellow in tone.
- 210071 **Mate IQ** (10 x 4g)
Ingredients: maté (min. 72.2%), ginkgo, pieces of guarana, guava and orange peel, flavouring, orange blossom, blue mallow flowers.
- 210527 **Strawberry & Champagne** (10 x 4g)
Ingredients: green Sencha tea, raisins, strawberry slices (min. 6.1%), rosebuds, flavouring, lavender flowers.
- 220700 **English Breakfast** (10 x 4g)
Ingredients: a rich blend of black teas with a high content of Assam.
- 220702 **Pu-Erh** (10 x 4g)
Ingredients: black tea from the Yunnan province with an earthy flavour, as well as a distinctive and rich aroma. A rare tea highly prized by Chinese emperors.
- 230003 **Earl Grey** (10 x 4g)
Ingredients: black Ceylon tea, bergamot flavouring.
- 260004 **Peppermint** (10 x 4g)
Ingredients: mint leaves.
- 260020 **Rooibos** (10 x 4g)
Ingredients: Twigs and leaves of rooibos.

Blooming teas

(packed individually, minimum order 10 pcs per type)

121249 Jin Zhan Mo Li "Marigold Jasmine"

This is a fine white tea produced in northern Fujian province from the "Da Hao" variety. When brewing, the tea leaves reveal yellow marigolds that gradually burst into bloom, from the centre of which emerges a garland of jasmine blossom. The taste and aroma are very fine with a trace of jasmine blossom.

121250 Bai He Xian Zi "Divine Lily"

A fine white tea originating from the north of Fujian province. When brewing, the tea leaves gradually release a round red amaranth connected to a jasmine chain with lilies. Its taste and aroma is light, harmonious and slightly flowery.

121251 Man Tian Xian Tao "Sacred Flowers"

A hand-rolled white tea from Fujian province. When brewing, the leaves gradually open to reveal hidden marigold flowers tightly bound with a round red amaranth and topped with jasmine blossom. The subtle flowery scent and rich infusion create a very harmonious combination.

121252 Huang Jia Bai He "Imperial Lily"

An exquisite white tea produced in northern Fujian province from the "Da Hao" variety. When brewing, the leaves open to reveal yellow marigolds topped with orange lilies. The taste of the infusion yields a perfect balance of white tea and flowery sweetness.

121242 Ai Xing Feng Xian "Love Heart"

This tea comprises a special white tea, jasmine blossoms, amaranth and lilies and is hand-rolled into the shape of a heart. When brewing, the lily flower is initially revealed from the tangle of green leaves, followed by a fresh flower of amaranth, with a small jasmine blossom appearing at the very end. Its fragrance is structured, fresh with a long lasting taste.

121241 Hao Shi Cheng Shuang "Double Happiness"

Utilising top quality white tea leaves, marigold and amaranth flowers are carefully rolled into a kidney-like shape. When brewing, the marigold flowers uncurl first, with red round amaranth flowers emerging at the top. The infusion is strong with a rich and prolonged scent.

121240 Niu Lang Zhi Nu "Date of Lovers"

This tea is made of fine white tea leaves, jasmine blossom and amaranth flowers. Vaguely reminiscent of a rabbit in shape, it gradually opens when brewing, with jasmine blossom appearing out of the red round flowers. The infusion boasts a rich aroma and fresh taste.

121230 Bai He Yu Die "Butterfly and Lily"

The gathered leaves are left to wither, then they are gently dried and steamed. This facilitates for the smoothness essential for hand-rolling. After brewing, the leaves gradually open to reveal orange lily flowers, giving the tea its velvety flavour of sweet apricots.

121239 Shuang Long Xi Zhu "Two Dragons Playing with a Pearl"

This is made of the finest white tea leaves, jasmine blossom, marigold and amaranth flowers. When brewing, this tea starts slowly to develop like a bud and gradually two jasmine blossoms emerge from it followed by a red amaranth flower. The infusion is rich and refreshing in aroma and the taste is distinctive and long-lasting.

121238 Yu Guan Yin "Jade Goddess of Mercy"

Made of the finest white tea, marigold and amaranth flowers, this tea is also known as Jade Kwan Yin. Whilst brewing, the leaves open in two layers and reveal marigold flowers and a red round amaranth flower at the top.

121234 Bu Bu Gao Sheng "Tempting Expectations"

The gathered leaves are left to wither, then they are gently dried and steamed. This facilitates for the smoothness essential for hand-rolling. After brewing, the leaves open to create a star with a wreath of marigold flowers. The tea forms a unique combination of white tea and flowery sweetness.

121232 He Jia Huan Le "Family Fortune"

The gathered leaves are left to wither, then they are gently dried and steamed. This facilitates for the smoothness essential for hand-rolling. After brewing, the tea leaves open to reveal an orange lily flower and a chain of jasmine blossoms giving the infusion a sweet honey tint.

121231 Xu Ri Dong Sheng "Rising Sun"

The gathered leaves are left to wither, then they are gently dried and steamed. This facilitates for the smoothness essential for hand-rolling. After brewing, the leaves open and reveal hidden amaranth and lily flowers. The infusion is seductive in taste and full of sparkling freshness.

110137 Jasmine Silvery Strawberry Flower

Hand-rolled green tea from Fujian province. Its very fine green tea leaves and buds are curled into a shape of a strawberry and decorated with red globe amaranth flowers. Such shaped strawberries are then scented with jasmine flowers that open when brewed.
